PUBLIC NOTICE

ROADSIDE SPRAYING

For the promotion of public health and safety as noted within subsection 7.1 (2) of the *Pesticides Act*, the Municipality of Mississippi Mills intends to utilize Wagar & Carput Weed Control Inc. to control weeds in areas along pre-selected municipal roadsides. Wagar & Carput Weed Control Inc. may be reached at 613-938-2117 (collect calls accepted).

For a portion of its Roadside Maintenance Program, the Municipality will use Clearview Herbicide (PCP#29752), active ingredients Metasulfuron-Methyl and Aminopyralid (present as potassium salt), Gateway Adjuvant (PCP#31470), active ingredients Paraffinic Oil and Alkoxyated alcohol non-ionic surfactant, under the *Pest Control Products Act* (Canada). Herbicide treatment for weeds will occur between July 2020 and October 2020, weather permitting.
