A Community Services Master Plan is a strategic plan to help guide the delivery of recreation and culture services and events as well as childcare services for the Municipality.

This project will develop a shared understanding of the services and the future direction they will take in conjunction with the changes and growth of the Municipality. The Plan will shape and lead the delivery of our community services over the next 10 years.

This Master Plan will include reviewing all recreation parks, facilities, programming, culture, public art, heritage, staffing components of the Recreation and Culture department, as well as Childcare services.

A Steering Committee will guide the overall work of the project as well as review recommendations at key steps in the project to ensure that the recommendations align with Council and Corporate direction.

Councillors Ferguson, Lowe and Torrance are the Council members of the Steering Committee for the Master Plan. The Steering Committee also includes Municipal staff.
