Transportation Master Plan FAQ

What is a Transportation Master Plan?

A Transportation Master Plan (TMP) is a high-level strategic planning document guiding the planning, expansion, and management of multi-modal transportation system to its planning horizon. A TMP identifies the policies and projects that will support the vision and meet short-and long-term transportation needs.

Why is the Transportation Master Plan Important?

The Municipality of Mississippi Mills is projecting long-term growth and the TMP will develop a practical and affordable plan to meet the transportation needs of the municipality's existing and future residents.

What types of services will be considered in the plan?

The Transportation Master Plan will consider:

- population growth
- opportunities to connect communities
- vehicle mobility
- active transportation
- safety and accessibility

It's important to note that the TMP does not cover a road condition assessment. Concerns with existing road surface quality, including potholes, should be reported directly to the Public Works department.

How is the community being consulted for the plan?

Consultations for the plan include:

- Meetings with municipal staff and members of Council
- Meetings with community and agency stakeholders
- In-Person Public Information Centres
- Online Community Transportation Survey
