This week we are featuring **Traffic and Parking By-law** (By-law 02-27) and **Use and Care of Roads By-law** (02-100) which contain information regarding **Winter Parking Restrictions** and **Winter Road Use and Care** within Mississippi Mills.

## Quick facts:

- No parking is permitted on any road or municipal parking lot between the hours of 1:30 am to 7:00 am from December 1 in any year to March 31 of the following year.
- No parking is permitted on any road when it is specifically marked with signs indicating snow removal.
- No parking is permitted on any road that may interfere with the movement of traffic or the clearing of snow.
- When clearing snow from your property, you may not throw or deposit snow or ice
  on a road or sidewalk. Also, be a considerate neighbour and don't pile snow on their
  property.
- If your roof accumulates ice and or snow that may fall on a pedestrian or vehicle, the owner and/or occupant of the building is responsible for the removal of snow and ice from the roof.
