

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MISSISSIPPI MILLS

BY-LAW 02-103

BEING a by-law to delegate the authority to temporarily close a municipal highway

WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O.2001, Section 42, a municipality may delegate to a committee of council or to an employee of the municipality, subject to any conditions which the municipality may impose, the power to close a highway temporarily for any purpose specified in the by-law;


AND WHEREAS it is deemed appropriate for Council to delegate the authority to close municipal highways to specific personnel for health and safety reasons, emergency reasons or for the purposes of maintenance;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Mississippi Mills enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the following positions be authorized to temporarily close a municipal highway:
 - Director of Roads & Public Works
 - Operations Manager
 - Patrol Supervisor
 - Manager, Lanark County Ambulance Service
 - Fire Chief/Deputy Fire Chief
 - Chief of Police/Ontario Provincial Police
2. **THAT** the above noted positions are granted right by Council to temporarily close a municipal highway for any construction or emergency purpose, where it is deemed appropriate to do so.
3. **THAT** the provisions of this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of January, 2003.

READ a first and second time this 10th day of December 2002.

READ a third time, passed, signed and sealed in Open Council this 10th day of December 2002.
