### Development Charges Explained

Development charges are one-time fees levied by municipalities on new construction of residential and non-residential development. They help pay for a portion of growth-related capital infrastructure.


The fees are collected from developers when a building permit is issued.

The Municipality must comply with the Development Charges Act when determining how much the charges will be and the types and value of infrastructure they can help support.
