## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MISSISSIPPI MILLS

## **BY-LAW NO. 02-78**

**BEING** a by-law prohibiting littering on private or municipal property.

**WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 210(82) of the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1990, c. M-45 as amended, bylaws may be passed by the councils of local municipalities prohibiting the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality or any local board thereof without authority from the owner or occupant of such property;

**AND WHEREAS** in accordance with Section 15 of the Restructuring Order which states that "all bylaws and resolutions of the former municipalities and their local boards shall become the by-laws and resolutions of the new Town and its local boards and shall remain in effect in the areas of the former municipalities for five years, or until amended or repealed by the Council or Board of the new Town";

**AND WHEREAS** the former Township of Ramsay passed By-law 1513 and the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Mississippi Mills wishes to confirm the same By-law;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Mississippi Mills hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. No person shall throw, place or deposit, refuse or debris on private property or on property of the Municipality without authority from the owner or occupant of such property.
- 2. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to prohibit the throwing, placing or depositing or refuse or debris by any person on property of the Municipality designated by the Municipality for a Waste Disposal Site during normal operating hours.
- 3. **THAT** any person violating any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction shall be liable to a penalty pursuant to the Provincial Offences Act, Chap P.33, R.S.O. 1990 as amended.
- 4. **THAT** By-law 1513 of the former Township of Ramsay is hereby repealed
- 5. **THAT** this by-law shall come into force and effect on the day of its passing.
